In accordance with Governor Cuomo's Executive Orders, the Library will remain temporarily closed until deemed safe to reopen. In the meantime, we are preparing the building and our services to adapt to a new normal.

The Library staff have been hard at work to provide you with online services and virtual experiences. On the Library's website, click on the Library Programs & Events calendar AND Community Programs & Events calendar for a complete listing of programs and events.

We have many resources available to you 24 hours a day, including an expansive digital collection of books, magazines, movies, music and online learning classes. You will find some of these resources highlighted in this newsletter.

Along with other Suffolk County libraries, the Sayville Library's 3D Printer has been used to produce face shields for our health care workers across the county. As of this printing, 4,465 face shields have been delivered to Stony Brook University Hospital, 100 to Sayville's Community Ambulance Company, and 2,495 to 67 Healthcare/EMS organizations.

I'd like to take a moment to thank the staff of our remarkable library, for their vision, adaptability and continued effort to provide new and innovative services to the community. On behalf of the Library, we wish you and your families' good health and safe well-being. I hope you will continue to turn to the Sayville Library as a place for information, solace and support.

Budget Vote & Trustee Election

The Library board voted unanimously at a trustee meeting held virtually on Monday, April 13, 2020 to cancel its budget vote and keep the 2020-21 tax appropriation at the same level as the 2019-2020 budget. This means that the community will not see an increase in their Library taxes next year. The Library Board, recognizing the extreme economic distress that the current situation is having on our community, made the difficult decision to run the Library for the next year without a tax increase.

Incumbent Linda Halliday is running for the position of Library Trustee for a 5-year term.

All qualified voters of the Sayville Union Free School District will be sent an absentee ballot together with a postage-paid return envelope and instructions for completing the same. To be counted, all completed absentee ballots must be received in the Office of the District Clerk by 5:00 p.m. on June 9, 2020.

A qualified voter is a person who is a citizen of the United States, at least eighteen years of age, a resident of the District for at least 30 days prior to the date of the election, and who is not otherwise ineligible to vote under the provisions of section 5-106 of the Election Law (e.g. a person who has been adjudged to be mentally incompetent by a court).

In light of the limitations posed by COVID-19, there will be no in-person voter registration held at school district offices prior to the June 9, 2020 vote. If you are not currently registered to vote, registration with the County Board of Elections is available online through the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles website at https://dmv.ny.gov/more-info/electronic-voter-registration-application. Those wishing to register online must do so by May 26, 2020.





We sadly share the news of the passing of Library Clerk Jo Ann Ferrante. Jo Ann worked for the Library for 31 years and was beloved by staff and patrons alike.
